

CORRIGENDUM

Corrigendum BoR (20) 42, BEREC Guidelines to assist NRAs on the consistent application of Geographical surveys of network deployments

On page 10 of BoR (20) 42¹ of the BEREC Guidelines to assist NRAs on the consistent application of Geographical surveys of network deployments, the definition of “peak time” is replaced by the one provided in BoR (20) 165² of the BEREC Guidelines on Very High Capacity Networks, as it is indicated below:

Current text on page 10 BoR (20) 42

“Peak time” will not be defined by BEREC in these GL, as peak time may vary among networks and countries. NRAs should (if they find this necessary) provide guidance on this aspect.

Amended text

“Peak time” is defined by BEREC in BoR (20) 165 as “the time of the day with a typical duration of one hour where the network load usually has its maximum”. Peak time may vary among networks and regions. NRAs should (if they find this necessary) provide guidance on this aspect.
