- Between 2003 and 2004 he held the position of Secretary General of the Association for the Self-regulation of Commercial Communication "Autocontrol".
- From 1997 to 2003 he held different management positions in the Telecommunications Market Commission, in the audiovisual area and in the Telematic and Interactive services.
- Consultant to the World Bank (WB), the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and the Organization of American States (OAS) in different projects related to the communications sector.
- Professor of Journalism and Audiovisual Communication at the Carlos III University of Madrid and of Advertising and Intellectual Property Law at the Blanquerna School of Communication at the Ramón Llull University of Barcelona. Along with the above, he has taught at different Spanish and Latin American universities as a visiting professor.
