

## Privacy Statement

### Participation in BEREC or BEREC Office events via audio or video conference

[Regulation \(EC\) No 45/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data](#) applies to the processing of personal data carried out when processing requests to join BEREC or BEREC Office events via the BEREC Office audio-video conference facilities.

Further to Article 11 and Article 12 of Regulation 45/2001, the BEREC Office provides data subjects with the following information.

The controller is the BEREC Office.

The purpose of the processing operation is to ensure appropriate treatment of the requests to join BEREC or BEREC Office events via the BEREC Office audio-video conference facilities.

The legal basis for these processing operations is:

[Regulation \(EC\) No 1211/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2009 establishing the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications \(BEREC\) and the Office](#), in particular Articles 4 (11), 6 (2) and 7 (1).

This operation is lawful under Article 5(a) of Regulation (EC) No 45/2001.

The following categories of personal data are collected: identification and contact data of the event coordinator(s) from the BEREC Office and of the event participants.

Failure to communicate the personal data listed above will result in the rejection of the request for participation in a BEREC or BEREC Office event via the BEREC Office audio-video conference facilities.

The recipients of personal data collected are the BEREC Office staff providing administrative, logistical and technical support to the BEREC and BEREC Office events.

The data subjects are the event coordinator(s) from the BEREC Office and the event participants.

The retention period for keeping personal data provided in the requests for participation in BEREC or BEREC Office events by audio or video-conference facilities is two years as of the year following the last event day.

Data subjects have the right of access and the right to rectify their personal data. Any such request should be addressed to the BEREC Office at the following mailbox [IT-support@berec.europa.eu](mailto:IT-support@berec.europa.eu) and treated within 15 working days from the date of its registration.

Data subjects have the right to recourse to the BEREC Office Data Protection Officer ([dpo@berec.europa.eu](mailto:dpo@berec.europa.eu)) and/or to the [European Data Protection Supervisor](#) if they consider that their rights under Regulation 45/2001 have been infringed.
