BEREC Guidelines:

- Help National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) and Stakeholders, like mobile operators, professional associations, financial analysts, investors, internet service providers and others;
- Provide more detailed guidance and explain legal provisions for their practical usage;
- Must be taken into utmost account by NRAs;
- Ensure consistent application of legal provisions in the European Economic Area.
