Guidelines for the BEREC stakeholders joining the public debriefing on 16 June 2021

 - Choose "Sign in as guest".




3. Watch and interact with the livestream

- Use the button on the right side of the video window to change the layout of your view (you can choose to watch only the speakers, only the presentation, or mix them both).
- By clicking on the information (i) button on the right side to open the "Event Details" section, you will be able to find the link to the documents and other details.
- Toggle the speaker button on the right side of the video window to hear the sound.



4. Ask LIVE questions to the speakers

• You can ask questions by clicking the **Q&A button (?) on the right-side menu.** By submitting the question, the event host will be able to see your Display name.



- Your question could be made public for all the other event attendees to see it as well.
- All the questions will be passed to the speakers to be answered as far as possible during the Q&A sessions.
- You are also encouraged to send your question in advance, by emailing to press@berec.europa.eu

5. Meeting end and interruptions

- If there are technical difficulties, the stream will show the notification. Please wait few minutes/until the issue is fixed for the video to appear again and do not refresh the page! If you think that it is taking too long, contact the event host and ask for more information.
- Otherwise, if the end time is reached, the event is completed. Note: The system might display longer event duration than it actually is. It is for the purpose if the event goes longer than expected.

 - By default, browsers mute outgoing video sound. You have to remember to enable the sound!
