As a netizen committed to European values, I have already answered to several consultations, one of them headed by BEREC.

My feelings on network neutrality are clear and firm : it is no use to lose time discussing again, and telecom operators will not implement net neutrality if they are not compelled to do so: all reports show that they already distort it.
