Main Results of the 4th meeting of the BEREC Contact Network in 2016

The main objective of the meeting was to prepare the 29th ordinary plenary meetings of the BEREC Board of Regulators (BoR) and the BEREC Office Management Committee (MC) due to take place on 8 and 9 December 2016 in Berlin (Germany). Consequently, the BEREC Contact Network (CN) considered all possible topics to be included in the BoR and MC agendas and concluded the following:

I. Documents to be submitted to the BoR
