The BEREC Office Management Board held its 39th ordinary plenary meeting on 14 June 2019 in Ghent, Belgium.

Introduction and participation

The BEREC Office MB held its 39th ordinary plenary meeting on 14 June 2019 in Ghent, Belgium. The meeting was hosted by the Belgian Institute for Postal Services and Telecommunications (BIPT).

The meeting was attended by the heads and/or high-level representatives of the National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) with primary responsibility for overseeing the day-to-day operation of the markets for electronic communications networks and services established in each Member State of the European Union (EU), and by the European Commission. Heads and high-level representatives of the NRAs with which BEREC concluded working arrangements also took part in the meeting.

She also reported that there are no plans for amending the BEREC Office budget 2019 in order to collect the financial contribution due from the new Participants that do not hold voting rights. She reported that according to the BAG's view, it would be preferred not to amend budget 2019 as the possible revenues and expenses (reimbursements) are in balance.

	accounts 2018, the MB reply to the preliminary observations of the European Court of Auditors (ECA) on the BEREC Office accounts for 2018, the update of the Financial Regulation and the rules on data protection.

6. BEREC Office 2020 and beyond

Document(s)	MB (19) 57 draft BEREC Office 2020 and beyond
Introduction by	Director of the BEREC Office and the Incoming BEREC Chair 2020
	Following the discussions during the Workshop "BEREC the next 10 years: Episode II", which took place in Budapest before the Plenary 1 2019, the Director of the BEREC Office presented to the BoR the document outlining the BEREC Office vision for 2020 and beyond.
	The document covers, among other things, the BEREC Office mission statement, mode of operation and governance, and allocation of resources per activity. The clarifications provided by the Commission have been welcomed.
Information pre- sented	The BEREC Office Director also introduced to the MB the updated Terms of Reference (i.e. definitions/functions) (i.e. definitions/functions) of the enhanced BAG and its role in the BEREC Office set-up. He noted that the BAG ToR would require further considerations and would imply amending the MB RoP. He suggested including them in an annex to the MB RoP.
	The Incoming BEREC Chair underlined that the presentation made by the Director is based on the workshops in Portoroz and Budapest. He expressed the view that the changes in the BEREC Office should have a positive impact on the functioning of the Board and the Office itself. He also welcomed the establishment of the enhanced BAG and clarified that the intention is to provide continuity in the work of the BAG.
	As next steps, after the endorsement of the approach and the main document as amended, it was suggested to launch a call for resources to the new BAG with a view that it would be operational on 1 January 2020 as latest.
Conclusions	The MB took note of the discussion and endorsed the document for internal use without Annex IV (Terms of Reference of the BEREC Office Advisory Group).

Introduction by	MB Chairperson (ComReg)
	According to Article 49 (3) of Regulation 2018/1971, the Management Board may decide to renew the term of office of the Director referred to in paragraph 2 of this Article for a further term. In doing so, the Management Board shall take into account the evaluation of the Director's performance and the BEREC Office's tasks and challenges.
Information pre- sented	The Management Board shall reach decisions on appointment, extension of the term of office or removal from office of the Director on the basis of a vote of a two-thirds majority of its members.
	A Director whose term of office has been extended shall not participate in another selection procedure for the same post after the end of the cumulative period.
	Where the term of office is not extended, the Director shall, upon a decision of the Management Board, remain in office beyond the expiry of the initial term of office until the appointment of a successor.
Conclusions	The MB approved the decision for publication and implementation and agreed to transmit the assessment of the performance of the BEREC Office Director to the EU institutions.
