



Notice for the launch of the public consultation on the draft BEREC Report on a consistent approach to migration and copper switch- off

During the 49th BEREC plenary meeting (9 December 2021), the Board of Regulators has approved the <u>draft BEREC Report on a consistent approach to migration and copper</u> switch-off for public consultation.

The objectives of this report are to provide an overview of the current status of the SMP operators' copper switch-off and the SMP operators' plans to switch off their copper network in the future, to analyze in detail the rules set by the NRAs for the migration process and copper switch-off and to examine also further aspects of the migration process and copper switch-off. Based on the results of this analysis, the report aims to identify a consistent approach to migration and copper switch-off.
