During this time, he has worked for the platform of public service provision at the front desk and mainly online. He has also held the position of the Technical Committee Chairperson for the projects of the “Digital Albania” program, part of the Albanian Government’s Regional Development Fund.

During 2017 - 2019, he worked as an ICT project Consultant in cooperation with UNDP, World Bank, and the CEC. In 2019, he worked at the MIE in the Broadband Development and Spectrum Policy Department for a brief time.

During 2019-2021, he worked at the Albanian Power Corporation as the Director of the Automatization and ICT Directorate, where he carried out innovative projects concerning corporate administration and production, as well as in the data transmission and system security area. Moreover, Mr. Bako has attended numerous trainings and obtained national and international certifications, including RIPE, ITU, EGA, ICDF, etc.

Since 2000, he has also been involved in the academic world as the technical leader of many graduates in the Faculty of Information Technology at the Polytechnic University of Tirana. He speaks English, Italian, and French. On 03.02.2021, Mr. Bako was appointed as an AKEP Steering Council Member by the Parliament of the Republic of Albania.
