

Decision No BoR/2024/07 of the Board of Regulators on the BEREC Working Groups and their Co-Chairs

The Board of Regulators,

HAVING REGARD TO Regulation No 2018/1971 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2018 establishing the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC) and the Agency for Support for BEREC (BEREC Office)¹, amending Regulation (EU) 2015/2120 and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1211/2009 (Text with EEA relevance) and, in particular Article 13 thereof;

HAVING REGARD TO the Rules of Procedure of the Board of Regulators² and, in particular Article 11 thereof;

HAVING REGARD TO the Rules of procedure on the operation of BEREC Working Groups³ and, in particular Article 1 thereof.

Whereas,

- 1) Where justified and, in particular, in order to implement BEREC's annual work programme, the Board of Regulators may set up working groups;
- 2) The Board of Regulators shall appoint the Chairs of the working groups, representing, where possible, different NRAs;
- 3) The term of the working groups' Co-Chairs shall be two calendar years;
- 4) The Board of Regulators has identified the priorities for 2025 in the BEREC Work Programme 2025⁴;
- 5) The Board of Regulators shall approve the decision that establishes the working groups and appoint their Co-Chairs for the following year before the end of each calendar year.
